If your child has medication in the health office, all medications and supplies must be picked up by an adult by the last day of school. DEVICE CARE & USE OVER THE SUMMER

Dear SDUSD families,



We would like to thank you for your support in our first year of implementing the 1:1 Device program. As we prepare for summer break there are a few reminders we would like to share with you.

Please note that **all students grades 2-11 will take their devices home for the summer** to support extended learning opportunities. Students attending the Summer Experience will be expected to bring their device with them each day. Others can use the devices at home to continue to work on math skills, access digital books, and more!

As you support your student during the summer months, please remember to:

1. Monitor screen time by limiting access to the device to only certain times of the day
2. Have your student use the device in an area where you are able to supervise
3. Keep the device away from water and other dangerous elements
4. Keep the device in a safe place when not in use

The Help Desk will be open during the summer months from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm, Monday through Friday. You can call (619) 732-1400 if you need support or visit the SDUSD IT Support site at <http://bit.ly/sdusditsupport>. It is expected that your student will bring their device to start the 2022 school year. If you move schools within the San Diego Unified School District, please take the device with you. If you are leaving San Diego Unified School District please return the device to your local school so that it can be removed from their record.
